

System Requirements

- Windows 7 or Windows 10
 (Windows 10 is recommended as it gives live pop-up notifications in the notification area. Windows 7 does not.)
- .NET 4.6.1
- Internet Connection
 (Either this computer or another computer on your organization's LAN needs an
 Internet connection. You can point non-Internet computers to an offline cache
 location on your LAN. For more information, see the Help documentation.)
- Access to TCP/IP and UDP, ports 80 and 8089
 (The computer with Internet connection needs to open ports 80 and 8089. Port 80 is for the downloads and general access to the update server at http://webupdater.hexagonmi.com. Port 8089 is for live update notifications.)

Version 1.3 Enhancements

- Added support to download installers that have more than one file. See HAC-1171.
- For products that are related to other associated products, we've added the ability show those associated products in a list. The list show products that are required as well as those that are only recommended. See HAC-120.
- Added a tool tip on the taskbar icon that indicates the number of updates pending. See HAC-1175.
- Improved the experience when you start the computer (or you start it from sleep) and there's no internet connection. You now get an error message of human readable text. See HAC-1164.
- Fixed an issue where if you installed Universal Updater on Windows 7 with a long folder pathway, a fatal error would occur. See HAC-1174.
- Fixed an issue where on certain products, if you removed that product, the Universal Updater would show a **Resume** button. It now shows a more intuitive Install button. See HAC-1269.
